Kicklighter Study Abroad Travel Grants

Each year, the Department of Germanic & Slavic Studies awards approximately 15 Kicklighter travel grants to students planning to study abroad during the summer or for the entire academic year. The grants normally range from **\$500 - \$1000** and are intended to encourage study abroad by defraying travel expenses for the student. They are also an academic distinction and are given on a competitive basis. Selection criteria include the student's overall academic standing, students' proficiency in German or Russian, course work in the field, and the nature and quality of the program a student plans to attend.

Eligible to apply are German, Russian, and Germanic & Slavic majors or minors. Students already receiving other travel funds from Germanic & Slavic Studies are not eligible.

Application materials required include:

- a one-page statement of purpose explaining why the student wants to study abroad and how the program will fit into the student's long-term academic and career objectives.
- a detailed description of the program students will be attending, specifying the length of the program and the level and nature of classes the student intends to enroll in (please do not simply include a print-out from a web site or a brochure).
