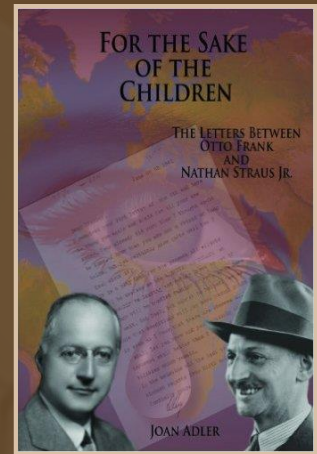


For the Sake of the Children
